Position: Favorable with Amendment

The Maryland Occupational Therapy Association supports *Senate Bill 482 - Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance Repayment Program - Mental Health Professionals in Public Schools.* The bill establishes permanent eligibility for mental health professionals in schools to participate in the Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance Repayment Program.

As members of the behavioral health team at schools, we strongly support this measure as part of the strategy to address the shortage of behavioral health professionals in schools. This is evidenced by recent reports that 1 in 3 adolescent girls have considered suicide.¹

We would like to request an amendment to clarify that occupational therpists and occupational therapy assistants are included in the program:

On page 2 in line 21 insert "OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT" after "SOCIAL WORKER SUPERVISOR"
