I am in support of HB447. I am a native of St. Mary's County MD. I have witness the intended effect of the Jim Crow era policy of At-Large/ Majority Voting as a tool to disenfranchise the election of candidates of color and those candidates' favored by communities of color. I think It can be fairly stated under the present process a person can be elected and not receive one vote from the district/ Precinct in which they are a candidate from because of the process of At-Large /Majority voting.
