We write in **support of SB 406**, which would provide that a first responder who is diagnosed by a licensed psychologist or psychiatrist with post–traumatic stress disorder is presumed, under certain circumstances, to have an occupational disease that was suffered in the line of duty and is compensable under workers' compensation law. This ensures closure of a gap that creates an inequality in coverage and would allow these effected first responders to get the essential care they need.
