These are a few quick examples I found and I am sure my list will grow.

It is appalling that NO Government issued identification is needed to cast a vote in this state. There is no signature verification even though it is written on the Absentee Ballot application website that your signature will be verified against your MVA driver's license.

My mother, who does not drive anymore, has a non-driver's (Photo ID) card. These are easy to get. If you have a validate SSN – MVA says "it will take a minimum of 48 hours to validate your information with the social security administration".
