HB 442 will exclude grants awarded for broadband expansion from state taxes. Such a move would allow companies in the business of deploying broadband to further invest more of their capital into the infrastructure needed to connect more Maryland communities to reliable broadband service. The expedited deployment of rural broadband is a critical component of economic growth and can help provide Maryland farms and agribusinesses the tools necessary to adopt the latest technology.

Technology continues to enhance agriculture's efficiency and many of these advances are supported by a strong backbone of broadband infrastructure. Maryland farmers embrace precision agriculture that allows them to reduce fertilizer and pesticide use, but those systems require strong internet connectivity. Modern barns can be controlled remotely to allow for increased heating or cooling, depending on the outdoor temperatures, but again those applications require broadband infrastructure. And on the day-to-day tasks of running a business, like monitoring markets, digital banking, or social media promotion of their products, farmers need reliable broadband service.
