SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 3 That Section(s) 17-1508(h) of Article - Education of the Annotated Code of Maryland be 4 renumbered to be Section(s) 7-1508(i). 5

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 7 as follows:

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7-1501. 9

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Article - Education

10 (k) "School security employee" means an individual, as defined in regulations 11 adopted by the Subcabinet, who:

12(1)Is not a school resource officer; and

13 (2)Is employed by a local school system to provide safety and security-related services at a public school. 14

7-1508. 15

Before the 2018-2019 school year begins, each local school system shall 16(e) (1)17file a report with the Center identifying:

18(i) The public high schools in the local school system's jurisdiction that have a school resource officer assigned to the school; and 19

20If a public high school in the local school system's jurisdiction is (ii) 21not assigned a school resource officer, the adequate local law enforcement coverage that 22will be provided to the public high school.

23Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, and each school year (2)24thereafter, before the school year begins, each local school system shall, in accordance with 25the plan developed under subsection (d)(2) of this section, file a report identifying:

26The public schools in the local school system's jurisdiction that (i) 27have a school resource officer assigned to the school; and

28If a public school in the local school system's jurisdiction is not (ii) 29assigned a school resource officer, the adequate local law enforcement coverage that will be 30 provided to the public school.

31(3)On or before October 1, 2018, and each October 1 thereafter, the Center 32shall submit a summary of the reports required under this subsection to the Governor and,

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2 (g) (1) **(I) [For] BEGINNING IN** fiscal year 2020 and [each fiscal year 3 thereafter] **ENDING IN FISCAL YEAR 2025**, the Governor shall include in the annual 4 budget bill an appropriation of \$10,000,000 to the Fund for the purpose of providing grants 5 to local school systems and local law enforcement agencies to assist in meeting the 6 requirements of subsection (e) of this section.

7 (II) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN 8 THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$15,000,000 TO THE FUND FOR 9 THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING GRANTS TO LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEMS AND LOCAL LAW 10 ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO ASSIST IN MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF 11 SUBSECTIONS (E) AND (H) OF THIS SECTION.

12 (III) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR 13 THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN 14 APPROPRIATION OF \$20,000,000 TO THE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING 15 GRANTS TO LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEMS AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO 16 ASSIST IN MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (E) AND (H) OF THIS 17 SECTION.

18 (2) Grants provided under this subsection shall be made to each local 19 school system based on the number of **f**schools**] STUDENTS ENROLLED** in each school 20 system in proportion to the total number of **f**public schools**] STUDENTS ENROLLED** in the 21 State in the prior year.

22 (H) A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM MAY USE FUNDS PROVIDED UNDER 23 SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION FOR SCHOOL SECURITY EMPLOYEES.

24 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 25 1, 2024.
