Subject: Request for FAVORABLE Report – SB 368 – State Retirement and Pension System – Military Service Credit - Eligibility

Dear Chair Guzzone and distinguished members of the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee:

On behalf of the members of the Maryland Military Coalition (MMC) and as its Communication Director (and as a U.S. Public Health Service retired officer), I write to recommend a **FAVORABLE report** by the Committee on SB 368 **State Retirement and Pension System** – **Military Service Credit** – **Eligibility.** This bill expands the definition of "military service" as it relates to service credit in the State Retirement and Pension System (SRPS) to include service after May 7, 1975, with:

- 1. the commissioned corps of the Public Health Service;
- 2. the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA);
- 3. or, the Coast and Geodetic Survey. Any member with qualifying service may claim service credit for service in those branches that precedes or interrupts membership in SRPS, as specified in current law.

This expansion conforms with 10 U.S. Code § 101 – Definitions, which classifies both USPHS and NOAA officers as members of the "Uniformed Services"; and § 38 U.S. Code, 21 (21) which considers members of USPHS and NOAA" as Active Duty. Further this bill conforms to the term of "veteran" in Annotated Code of Maryland, Article 1, Section 28 "Rules of Interpretation", which became effective on July 1, 1984. Article 1 states:

WITH RESPECT TO <u>ANY STATE PROGRAM OF BENEFITS</u>, RIGHTS, OR PRIVILEGES APPLICABLE TO A <u>VETERAN</u> UNDER THIS CODE, THE TERM "<u>VETERAN</u>" INCLUDES <u>MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSIONED CORPS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE AND THE COMMISSIONED CORPS OF THE NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION</u> (OR ITS PREDECESSOR, THE COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY) IF ELIGIBLE UNDER § 101, TITLE 38 OF THE U.S. CODE.

SB 368 – SRPS – Military Service Credit – Eligibility – FAVORABLE

The Maryland Military Coalition *strongly supports* **SB 368** a– State Retirement and Pension System – Military Service Credit – Eligibility and asks for a *FAVORABLE* report from the Budget and Taxation Committee. Passage of this bill has the potential to attract more retirees from USPHS and NOAA to your 10,000 state government vacancies, it enhances the Moore Administration's Year of the Military Families and is in keeping with the Governor's mantra: "Leave No One Behind".

The Maryland Military Coalition is a non-partisan organization of 21 Veteran organizations representing over 150,000 Maryland uniformed services men and women and their families -- almost half of the 355,000 veterans in the State.

We want to thank Senator Waldstreicher and Senator Gile for sponsoring this important legislation and their continued strong, support of the uniformed services community in Maryland.
