**RE:** Senate Bill 603 – Internet Gaming – Authorization and Implementation –  
**Letter of Information with Amendments**

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The Office of Attorney General respectfully submits this letter of information for this Committee's use when deliberating Senate Bill 603 – Internet Gaming – Authorization and Implementation. Senate Bill 603 (1) authorizes the State Lottery and Gaming Control Commission to license video lottery operators and up to five other specified qualified applicants to conduct and operate Internet gaming in the State and (2) provides for the distribution of Internet gaming proceeds.

If the State were to authorize and implement a Statewide internet gaming industry, it is imperative to ensure that the proper supports are in place for any individuals who may experience negative effects of Internet gaming. The Office of the Attorney General urges the Committee to amend Senate Bill 603 to allow 1% of Internet gaming proceeds to go to the Algorithmic Addiction Fund (established by Senate Bill 739 of 2024), if passed by this General Assembly.
