Senate Bill 693 is legislation authorizing the County Commissioners of Carroll County to borrow not more than \$29,800,000 in order to finance the construction, improvement, or development of certain public facilities in Carroll County, and to allow such borrowing by the issuance and sale at public or private sale of its general obligation bonds.

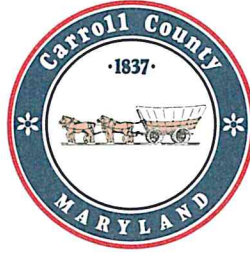
