

Testimony - HB 1314Right to Start Act_ March 05, 2024

As the President of the Maryland State Family Child Care Association (MSFCCA), representing over 4,000 family childcare providers in our state, I am writing to express our strong support for House Bill 1314, also known as the Right to Start Act.

This bill, which proposes to waive the filing fee for certain business entities for the first year of their existence, holds significant implications for the childcare sector in Maryland. By alleviating the financial burden of the initial filing fee, the Right to Start Act aims to encourage the establishment of new businesses, including family childcare programs.
