The Episcopal Diocese of Maryland strongly supports this Bill. This Bill would offer privacy and safety to Maryland children online by offering a comprehensive set of rules for the protection of children's data within the context of what is in the child's

best interest. The policies and standards set forth provide safety and privacy for children in part by restricting data collection, sharing, profiling and the use of data in

ways that are detrimental to the child.

The Episcopal Church believes strongly that each child is a child of God and deserves protection from in-person and online harassment. A child routinely needs to access the internet to conduct research, etc. for school. A child should not have to be concerned about possible exploitation as a result of their online activity.
