RE: **SB 0364** – Election Law – Casting General Election Ballot in Multiple States – Prohibition **FAVORABLE**

Dear Chairman Feldman and Committee Members,

The Maryland Federation of Republican Women strongly supports SB 0364 to prohibit a voter from voting in the same General Election in more than one state.

Our democracy is based on the principle of "one person, one vote". Every registered voter is entitled to vote for every office on the ballot – ONCE-- in each election.

Fair and honest general elections require that voters cast just one vote for their U.S. Congressional Representatives, Senators and the President of the United States.

Voting in more than one state for these national offices in a single election year is intentional and should be subject to prosecution.

Please give **SB 0364** a **FAVORABLE** Report.
