Subject: **Request for FAVORABLE Report** – SB 0448 – Commission to Study African American Civil War Soldiers in Maryland

Dear Chair Feldman and members of the Committee:

On behalf of the members of the Maryland Military Coalition (MMC), I write to recommend a **FAVORABLE report** by the Committee on SB 0448 the *Commission to Study African American Civil War Soldiers in Maryland*, sponsored by Delegate Bouchat. This bill will establish a Commission which will study the history of African American Soldiers who fought for the Union Army and make recommendations for an appropriate memorial.

Many African Americans fought valiantly on behalf of the Union. However, the extent of their participation, their individual stories, and unit history are not well known, including African American Soldiers from Maryland. The Commission proposed in this legislation will address this gap by studying the history of African American Civil War Soldiers and publishing its findings to enhance public awareness.

Most importantly, the Commission will make recommendations for an appropriate memorial to African American Civil War Soldiers. The monument will serve to not only memorialize those warriors but serve as an inspiration for future generations.

The Maryland Military Coalition **strongly supports SB0488** and asks for a *FAVORABLE* report from the Committee.

The Maryland Military Coalition is a non-partisan organization of 21 Veteran organizations representing over 150,000 Maryland uniformed services men and women and their families -- almost half of the 355,000 veterans in the State.
