RE: SB 597 - Human Services - Individuals with Disabilities and Service-Disabled Veterans Boating Fund Position: Favorable with Amendments

Dear Chair Feldman and Committee Members,

The Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs ("MDVA") supports Senate Bill 597 - Human Services - Individuals with Disabilities and Service-Disabled Veterans Boating Fund.

The MDVA supports the establishment of this fund to provide sailing, boating, kayaking, canoeing, and paddleboarding opportunities for individuals with disabilities and service-disabled veterans.

We agree with the Department of Disabilities and suggest the following amendments to expand the program to include: (1) Nonprofits offering surfing opportunities for individuals with disabilities to be eligible for the grant funding, (2) Remove the mention of "Chesapeake Bay or its tributaries."

These amendments would allow the fund to promote adapted water activities more equitably across the state and beyond the Chesapeake Bay region. I respectfully ask the Committee for a favorable report with amendments to SB 597.
