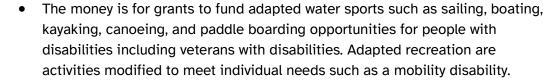

WHAT does this legislation do?

WHAT do the proposed amendments do?

Together, all of these amendents expand access and opportunity to adapted water sports for people with disabilities.

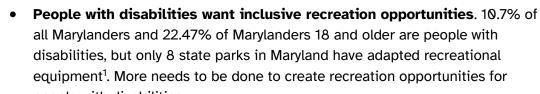


- Replaces "Boating Fund" in the title with "Adapted Water Sports Funds."
- Replaces "Boating Fund" with "Adapted water sports fund" on page 2, line 14.
- Adds "surfing" to the list of adapted water sports on page 2, line 16 and page 3, line 10
- Removes "on the Chesapeake Bay or its tributaries at least 25 times in each of the past 3 years on page 3, line 26-27.



WHY is this legislation important?

Adapted recreation creates opportunity. Adapted recreation allows people with disabilities to participate in sports and leisure activities with others. This allows everyone to have recreation opportunities regardless of their disability.
