**Re: SB 810 - OPPOSE**

The Maryland-Delaware-District of Columbia Press Association represents a diverse membership of newspaper publications, from large metro dailies such as the Washington Post and the Baltimore Sun, to hometown newspapers such as the Star Democrat and Dorchester Banner, to publications such as The Daily Record, Baltimore Jewish Times, and online-only publications such as the Baltimore Banner, MoCo 360, Maryland Matters and Baltimore Brew.

The Press Association asks for an unfavorable report on SB 810, which would allow Dorchester County government to exempt leases of five years or less from public notice requirements. We believe that this change would lead to more secrecy in government real estate decisions.

Public notice statutes require governments to share information about their actions. Disposition of real estate, even on a lease, is a matter of considerable public interest. Diminishing the public's right to know on these matters is not good public policy.

We urge an unfavorable report.
