The Maryland Veterans Caucus, House Membership respectfully requests a favorable report on **HB 1087 - Institutions of Higher Education - Online Gambling - Prohibition.** This bill was sponsored by Delegate **Queen** for the purpose of prohibiting the use of online gambling websites and programs on the campuses of higher education in Maryland. This bill would also require the institutions to create a geofence, which is a virtual perimeter, around the entire campus which would prevent the students from accessing online gambling programs.
