
- Two main types of dredge material
 - Non-Baltimore Harbor material, and
 - Baltimore Harbor material
- <u>Non-Baltimore Harbor</u> material is relocated to Bay
- <u>Baltimore Harbor</u> material stored away from Bay
- <u>Dredging needed</u> for commerce and recreation.
- Baltimore harbor materials are primarily sent to the <u>Cox Creek Material Containment Facility</u> located in my district.




CAD: Should it be used in Maryland? If so, how?

"Confined aquatic disposal (CAD) cells used ... for the <u>disposal of dredged</u> <u>material deemed unsuitable (UDM) for unconfined open water disposal</u>. The technique involves placing UDM within cells cut into the seafloor for containment"




Unhealthy Dumping Grounds




Timeline
