

Senate 537 -limiting the development of marijuana shops

As a Vice President of the Ritchie Heights Ritchie Manor Civic Association, a community consisting of 240 single family homes, in Prince Georges County. I am opposing the senate bill 537. I am in favor of the County to restricting the proliferation of marijuana stores/tobacco shops in our community. Currently marijuana stores/tobacco shops have saturated Marlboro Pike, a stretch of county roadway southeast of the District of Columbia city line. In one block we have marijuana stores/tobacco shops in each block and in one case, directly across the street from each other.
