Tricare Premium Program Reimbursement For Brigadier General Andrew Collins

The demands of the Guard often require service members to take time away from work and their families to serve their country. It is only fitting that we provide them with the support they need, including affordable health care.

Governor Moore proclaimed 2024 as Maryland's "Year of the Military Family." Providing health care for them is an important tool for recruiting and retention of Maryland's citizen soldiers and airmen.

Please consider this critical readiness issue for Guard members to be always there when the state and nation needs them. Our citizen Soldiers and Airmen are worth the investment and I know it will make us a better state now and into the future as we can retain their incredible talent and dedication.

In conclusion, I respectfully ask the Committee for a favorable report on the Health Care for Heroes Tricare Premium Reimbursement Program.
