RE: Proposed Amendment HB0289

The proposed amendment is as follows:

Pg 1, Line 21, after "**STATE**" insert: "**WITHOUT LIMITATION**".

Reasoning: It is not lawful for a contract to bind the State to *unlimited* indemnification agreement but not unlawful to promise indemnification limited to a fixed dollar amount applicable to certain circumstances.
