Bill: SB 119 – Legally Protected Health Care – Gender Affirming Care

Hearing Date: March 20, 2024

Position: Support

The Licensed Clinical Professional Counselors of Maryland (LCPCM) strongly supports *Senate Bill* 119 – Legally Protected Health Care – Gender Affirming Treatment. This legislation would extend Maryland's reproductive health shielding law to gender affirming care.

Twenty-two states have banned gender-affirming care for minors. We are deeply concerned about the impact on the mental health of youth in those states. For transgender and nonbinary youth, gender affirming care reduces the rate of depression by 60% and suicide ideation by 73%.ⁱ This legislation is urgently needed to protect people who come to Maryland for gender-affirming care, their families, and their Maryland providers.
