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TESTIMONY ON HB#/0400 - FAVORABLE

Maryland Medical Assistance Program and Health Insurance - Annual Behavioral Health Wellness Visits - Coverage and Reimbursement

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My name is Richard K. Kaplowitz. I am a resident of District 3. I am submitting this testimony in support of HB#0400, Maryland Medical Assistance Program and Health Insurance - Annual Behavioral Health Wellness Visits - Coverage and Reimbursement

The pandemic has caused a precipitous increase in mental health issues in our children. Nationally, the number of children ages 3 to 17 who experienced anxiety or depression increased by 25% from 9.4% in 2016 to 11.8% in 2020. The figures are based on those either diagnosed with or reported to have those symptoms by a doctor or health care provider.

During that same timeframe, Maryland ranked 13th in the nation with a 36% increase of children ages 3 to 17 with anxiety or depression either reported to or diagnosed by a doctor or health care provider. <u>https://www.marylandmatters.org/2022/09/26/report-md-children-and-youth-continue-to-experience-mental-health-challenges/</u>

This bill says that behavioral health is as important as physical health and should be a covered service so that everyone can maintain and improve their mental health without cost of care being the primary consideration on seeking those services. This bill calls on us to respond ethically and morally to the issue of caring for and about each other and providing for that care to every individual.
