POSITION & RATIONALE:

The Maryland Board of Pharmacy (Board) respectfully submits this letter of information for HB 1388 – Labor and Employment – Noncompete and Conflict of Interest Clauses – Veterinary and Health Care Professionals (HB 1388).

Workforce Availability

Noncompetition clauses and conflict of interest provisions further exacerbate the critical healthcare worker shortage. Prohibiting barriers which prevent a pharmacist from practicing pharmacy for certain employers has the potential to increase the ability of pharmacists to practice in their same specialized setting or geographic area and ultimately improve the quality of pharmacy services..

Access to Healthcare

Noncompetition clauses and conflict of interest provisions would restrict Marylanders from accessing the unique skill set of pharmacists. Prohibiting obstacles which prevent a pharmacist from practicing in pharmacy settings for which they were trained, or in geographic areas that are most convenient, enables a pharmacist to leverage their education, knowledge, and skills to create various pathways where patients may access pharmacy services.
