

## Testimony prepared for the Ways and Means Committee on House Bill 608 February 8, 2024 Position: Favorable

Madam Chair and members of the Committee, thank you for the opportunity to testify in favor of sufficient livelihood all. I am Lee Hudson, assistant to the bishop for public policy in the Delaware-Maryland Synod, <u>Evangelical Lutheran Church in America</u>; a faith community with three synods in every part of the Maryland.

Our community teaches that adequate income, public support for sufficient livelihood, and appropriately progressive taxation are benchmarks for a just public policy ["Sufficient, Sustainable Livelihood for All," ELCA, 1999]. Under that position we have supported Maryland's earned income tax credit and its expansion for several decades.

**House Bill 608** adds another increment of eligibility to what has been a bipartisan policy that has raised low-income individuals out of poverty. We believe that outcome speaks for itself. Indexing thresholds to account for cost rise is also a fair way to keep a floor under wages.

We ask a favorable report.
