

The Commissioners of St. Mary's County **SUPPORT WITH AMENDMENTS HB 938- State-Owned Nursing Homes – Deficiencies, Citations and Fines – Reporting Requirements** which is being heard in the Health and Government Operations Committee. The Commissioners of St. Mary's County request that HB 938 be amended to require that "*the local governing body in which the nursing home is located*" be added to the list to whom a deficiency or enforcement action is reported. Currently HB 938 language states that the deficiency or enforcement action would be given to the Governor, the Senate Finance Committee, the House Health and Government Operations Committee and the members of the General Assembly who represent the district in which the nursing home is located.
