Furthermore, the provision requiring the Governor to include an appropriation in the annual budget bill for staffing and software necessary to develop and maintain the dashboard underscores the legislature's commitment to ensuring the long-term success and sustainability of this initiative.

In conclusion, I urge you to support and pass this bill expeditiously. By establishing a procurement dashboard, we can foster greater transparency,
