RE: House Bill 722 Health - Minors - Gender and Sex Transition Procedures Bill

- Would protect the rights of a parent, guardian, or custodian to <u>dissent</u> to sex transition procedures on minors
- Would align with founding Judeo-Christian principles that the parent has the God-given responsibility to care for their own child in the manner aligning with Scripture which is a constitutionally protected right in the First Amendment Freedom of Religion clauses
- Should include protection against discrimination of hospitals and other healthcare providers who object to performing sex transition procedures on minors in violation of their rights of conscience and free exercise of religion

Committee Chair, the Honorable Delegate Lauren Arikan, and Health and Government Operations Committee Members:

I was a practicing Registered Nurse for twenty-six years, having obtained my BSN and Business of Nursing Graduate Certificate from Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing, followed by a Master of Business Administration from Drexel University LeBow College of Business. In addition, I was formerly a Certified Legal Nurse Consultant and am familiar with the duress that the individual, family, and healthcare practitioners experience in lawsuits involving permanent injuries of adults and children. I respectfully submit my testimony to you, as a Christian nurse and mother, as well as point out the potential detrimental effect that sex transition procedures and future contested procedures could be expected to have on healthcare workers in Maryland.

First, the standard by which the laws of our state and country were founded were upon the highest standard, that given by Creator God in Holy Scripture where we are told life was created by God for God¹, and as Ultimate Authority, God dictates how we should live to please Him.² Christians understand from the Bible that everyone is accountable to God³ and that Hell is real and a future reality for those who disobey God and reject the saving sacrifice of Jesus Christ.⁴ The Bible tells us that God created us in His

image,⁵ that He ordains our life and that it exists by His will for His purposes.⁶ In the book of Psalms we learn that God is present at our conception, when our inward parts are being formed and that all of our days are written in God's book before any of them came to be.⁷ This includes the designation of male and female, and not only sex assignment codified in DNA, but the Bible says **God blessed them** at the same time.⁸ Throughout the Bible, we can see that children are a blessing, a reward, a heritage and a source of strength in the family;⁹ a crown¹⁰ and a source of joy¹¹ and honor.¹²

The Bible has much to say about parents and the role that they are commanded by God to fulfil. First, children are to honor and **obey their parents**¹³, as parents are to instruct and care for their children, including teaching them what their Creator God says about their bodies¹⁴. Therefore, parental consent should be required on all procedures performed on children, and the governing authorities are expected by God to use their authority for good as you have a special accountability before God. ¹⁵ This includes the right to dissent to ungodly and harmful medical procedures.

According to The Linacre Quarterly peer-reviewed academic journal on medical ethics:¹⁶

"Given the early age at which youth seek treatment for transsexual attractions (TSA) and gender dysphoria and given the <u>serious risks</u> associated with such treatment, it is <u>essential that family and youth</u> <u>be advised</u> about these risks and alternative treatment options. Physicians and mental-health professionals have a <u>professional responsibility</u> to know and <u>communicate the serious risks</u>, in particular <u>risk of suicide</u>, that are associated with SRS; the spontaneous resolution of TSA in youth; the <u>psychological conflicts</u> that have been identified in such patients and in their parents; the successful treatment of conflicts associated TSA and the regrets of those who have been through SRS."¹⁷
