Subject: Request for FAVORABLE Report – SB0055 – Vehicle Laws – Disabled Veteran Registration Plates -- Issuance

Dear Chair Smith and distinguished members of the Judicial Proceedings Committee:

On behalf of the members of the Maryland Military Coalition (MMC) and as its Legislative Director, I write to recommend a FAVORABLE report by the Committee on SB0055 – Vehicle Laws – Disabled Veteran Registration Plates – Issuance, sponsored by Senator William Smith, Jr. This legislation authorizes the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue certain special registration plates to those disabled veterans with a service-connected disability rating between 50 percent and 99 percent, inclusive, as designated or classified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

The MMC strongly supports the expansion of the availability of Disabled Veteran Registration Plates to those eligible individuals as proposed by this legislation. In its latest report, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs indicates there are 42,005 veterans in Maryland with a service-connected disability rating between 50 percent and 99 percent.¹ The adoption of this bill will create an added benefit for those veterans in this category.

The Maryland Military Coalition **strongly supports** SB0055 and asks for a *FAVORABLE* report from the Judicial Proceedings Committee. This bill builds on the Moore Administration's Year of the Military Families, providing another benefit that assists and helps the veterans and their families who have bravely served, fought, and sacrificed for our state and country.

The Maryland Military Coalition is a registered non-profit, non-partisan advocacy organization comprised of 21 prominent Maryland-based veteran and military groups, representing over

The Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs ("MDVA") supports Senate Bill 55 - Vehicle Laws - Disabled Veteran Registration Plates - Issuance.

The MDVA believes it is important to recognize and honor the service of all veterans - including those who may have become disabled while serving in uniform. We acknowledge that veterans might have been awarded a disability compensation rating of less than 100%, but continue to feel a significant impact from their service-connected disabilities.
