**Re: HB440 – Motor Vehicle Registration – Exceptions for Golf Carts - Cobb Island**

This bill when passed would allow the use of golf carts on Cobb Island in Charles County:

1. On highways which the maximum posted speed does not exceed 30 miles.
2. Between the hours of dawn and dusk
3. For drivers with a valid driver's license
4. If the golf cart is equipped with lighting devices as required by the Motor Vehicle Administration.

This is a Charles County delegation bill with unanimous support from the Charles County Board of Commissioners and the Charles County House and Senate Delegations. We have submitted a Delegation support letter, tally sheets and Charles County Board of Commissioner's letter of support.

We respectfully request a favorable report on HB-440 – Motor Vehicle Registration – Exceptions for Golf Carts- Cobb Island.
