This provision ensures that individuals with disabilities can still enjoy the freedom and exhilaration of motorcycle travel while maintaining their safety and the safety of others on the road.

SB730 aligns with our shared commitment to improving road safety and reducing the risk of motorcycle accidents and injuries in Maryland.

I urge all members of the Maryland General Assembly to support SB730 and prioritize the safety and well-being of motorcyclists and their passengers. Together, we can make Maryland roads safer for everyone.

We completely agree with stipulating that the passenger must be able to reach the footrests.
