Greetings. I am writing on behalf of my organization, the Palestinian Christian Alliance for Peace (PCAP.) I am co-chair of this national group that advocates for peace and justice in Israel/Palestine, with equal rights for all Palestinians, Jews, and others who are inhabitants of the Holy Land.

We urge against the adoption of HB0763, effectively banning the Council on American Islamic Relations (CAIR) from the Commission on Hate Crime Response and Prevention.
