As a facility owner and operator, the foreseeable risks associated with the adoption of this bill will create an environment with disproportionate risk. The costs to cover actual liabilities will far outweigh our ability to charge consumers rates for services rendered.

There are risks associated with all of the natures of activities conducted within our facilities. Of which, the vast majority are inherently present due to the nature of the activity, not the negligence of our operators, staff or facility itself.
