TESTIMONY ON HB#/0436 - FAVORABLE
Election Law - Voter Registration - Age and Notification to Minors

My name is Richard K. Kaplowitz. I am a resident of District 3. I am submitting this testimony in support of HB#0436 Election Law - Voter Registration - Age and Notification to Minors

I am proud to support this effort by my Delegate Kris Fair to make the Frederick County Public Schools Strategic Plan Goal #1 a shared goal across the state of Maryland. That goal, in the goal area of Organizational Culture of Achievement, states “FCPS will equip each and every student to be an empowered learner and **an engaged citizen** to achieve a positive impact in the local and global community.”

Participation in voting and our political system is the essence of civics and citizenship. Not every student, especially in minority and lower income student populations, will go to the Department of Motor Vehicles and register to vote at that time. We are failing those students when we do not inform them that their cohort, just because they have access to an ability to drive, are registering. We are also missing out on the opportunity to recruit those newly registered voters to serve their community as election judges, a job which requires they first register.

Voter registration is a non-partisan activity, no partisan advantage is automatically conferred when that minor becomes a registered voter. If we are to increase teaching our youth that citizenship confers not only privileges but also requirements this bill facilitates that process.

I respectfully urge this committee to return a favorable report on HB#0436.
