RE: HB063 – Property Tax - Credit for Dwelling House of Disabled Veterans -Alterations

The Maryland Veterans Caucus, House Membership respectfully requests a favorable report on HB063 – Property Tax - Credit for Dwelling House of Disabled Veterans - Alterations

This bill was sponsored by **Delegate Pruski.** This bill alters eligibility for a certain property tax credit against the county or municipal corporation property tax on the dwelling house of certain disabled veterans to include individuals who have been declared by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs to have a certain nonpermanent, service–connected disability rating, alters the criteria for determining the amount of the credit; and generally relating to a property tax credit for the dwelling house of a disabled veterans.
