Testimony in Favor of HB0952 Income Tax - Subtraction Modification - Military Retirement (Keep Our Heroes Home Act)

Chair Atterbeary and members of the Ways and Means Committee,

I respectfully request a favorable report of HB0952. This bill will increase from \$15,000 to \$20,000 the amount of subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for individuals who are at least 55 years of age for retirement income received as a result of the individual's military service.

In result of expanding the subtraction modification, Maryland can expect growth in migration. These changes will make our great state of Maryland a more desirable place to live for military retirees. This will encourage current Marylanders to continue to live and spend in our state while also making it a great competitor for retirees who currently live out of state to consider moving to Maryland rather than our competing neighbors.
