

House Bill 142 – Election Law – Election Administration – State Administrator, Local Boards, and Election Directors

Favorable with the following amendment

- 1. Remove “(5) AT LEAST ANNUALLY, PROVIDE A PERFORMANCE EVALUATION OF THE ELECTION DIRECTOR OF EACH LOCAL BOARD TO THE LOCAL BOARD, INCLUDING ANY RECOMMENDED DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH STATE LAWS, REGULATIONS, AND POLICIES; “**

The local boards are currently afraid to do anything that may be against or upset the State Administrator or State Board. The hope it would get better and once Linda Lomone left. There needs to be more distribution of ideas to the local boards since they are the ones who know their community and deal directly with their voters.
