The Real Property Section Counsel of the Maryland State Bar Association (MSBA) opposes House Bill 638 – State Transfer Tax – Rates and Distribution of Revenue – Alterations.

The bill seeks to increase the amount of transfer taxes on most residential property sales and many sales of commercial property. According to the Baltimore Sun, "Transfer taxes in Md. are fifth-highest in U.S., study finds".
