## TESTIMONY

**Committee:** House Appropriations Committee

- **Bill**: HB 865 Catastrophic Event Account Transfer of Funds State Disaster Recovery Fund
- **Position:** Support

## **Reason for Position:**

The Maryland Municipal League supports House Bill 865, which simply allows the Catastrophic Event Account to support the State Disaster Recovery Fund if the Fund's balance is depleted or deemed inadequate to provide local relief for a natural disaster or catastrophic situation.

The League strongly supported the creation of the State Disaster Recovery Fund in 2023, which is designed to provide swift assistance in areas faced with a significant local disaster that does not merit federal designation. The City of Annapolis was faced with such a scenario in the aftermath of the 2021 tornado. HB 865 would ensure there is a pathway to make monies available to any jurisdiction should disaster strike and the existing \$10 million in the Fund be depleted.
