Currently, I am the founder of Artistanda, LLC. My business concept is addressing a real need for accessibility in literacy and education.

I strongly support HB0678 and DCDL funding for two main reasons. First, without the DCDL support, books designed for Deaf people are very expensive. There are many Deaf people that recently lost federal jobs and so they need to continue educating themselves by reading books provided by DCDL. Second, the DCDL website is important for parents, educators of Deaf kids, and members of the Deaf community, because it houses and curates educational and community websites. Nowadays, language deprivation is a hot topic of discussion in the Deaf community. Without the DCDL website, it is hard to locate educational materials and events on the Internet for Deaf kids.
