Position:	Support the use of arbitration to settle impasses in collective bargaining for State Personnel- BWI Airport Fire & Rescue Department

HB 599 seeks to modify the collective bargaining plan between the State and uniformed fire employees of the BWI Fire and Rescue Department to add the use of arbitration to resolve negotiation impasse.

The Alternative Dispute Resolution Section Council of the Maryland State Bar Association supports any ADR process to assist the parties to come to some resolution on the matters they deem important. We therefore support the use of ADR processes proposed by this bill.

SB 373 was a cross-filed bill referred to the Senate Finance Committee. The hearing was set for 2/6 at 1:00PM. No vote has been taken. We urge a favorable Committee report and that it conform to SB 373.

The Section supports HB 599 so far as it offers the use of Arbitration as part of the collective bargaining plan between the State and uniformed fire employees of the BWI Fire and Rescue Department.
