Dear Chair Guzzone, Vice Chair Rosapepe, and Committee members:

I am writing in Support of SB0515 Public Libraries - State Library Resource Center - Funding

The Western Maryland Regional Library (WMRL) strongly supports **SB0515** Public Libraries – State Library Resource Center – Funding which would alter the calculation of certain funding for the State Library Resource Center. SLRC serves Maryland's public, academic, school, and special libraries. It provides statewide resources and services for Maryland libraries and their customers. In Western Maryland, SLRC plays an essential role in cultivating public libraries and the communities they support. These are just a few of the SLRC services that positively impact our region.

<u>Research databases</u>: SLRC provides a collection of research databases to our three public library systems and to the public school system. All residents have access to a core collection of databases for online language learning, family history research, job and career resources, general research support, test preparation, and more.

<u>Statewide interlibrary loan</u>: The Marina system, run by SLRC, allows Maryland public library cardholders to request materials not owned by their local public library system from another Maryland public library system. This highly popular sharing agreement gives our residents access to materials they would not otherwise be able to borrow. We have seen a steady growth in the use of this service over the past several fiscal years.

<u>Professional Development</u>: SLRC provides a full range of professional development opportunities for Maryland librarians, including online courses, in-person training, and conferences. This training helps librarians navigate issues such as virtual library services, customer service, and collection management.

<u>Delivery of Materials</u>: SLRC bears the full cost of delivering all of WMRL's Interlibrary loan materials around the state. This has a major positive impact on WMRL's budget and the efficiency of the delivery system. As the smallest of the Regional libraries, WMRL relies heavily on the services SLRC provides.

Maryland public libraries are among the strongest, if not the strongest system of public libraries in the nation. This is due in large part to the continued support of the Maryland General Assembly and its support of The State Library Resource Center for which I am very grateful. I respectfully ask for your support of SB0515.
