Maryland Motor Truck Association (MMTA) opposes SB859. Specifically, we are concerned about the imposition of a new 2.5% business transportation fee that would be incurred on corporate income over \$10,000,000.

According to CNBC, as of 2024 Maryland ranks 47th in cost of doing business, meaning we are the fourth most expensive state in the country. This was recognized by the Governor, who noted the state needs a plan to stimulate economic growth and attract businesses rather than continue lagging behind our adjacent states. Inasmuch as the passage of this legislation will only serve in direct contradiction to those goals by further increasing the costs of business operations, MMTA asks for an unfavorable report.
