Testimony in Support of HB410

Testimony by Delegate Andrew Pruski
February 17, 2025 – Economic Matters

What the Bill Does:

The purpose of HB410: Anne Arundel County – Board of License Commissioners – Chief Inspector – Compensation updates the pay schedule for this position from a Grade NR-5 (\$35,318-\$63,445 annual salary range) to an NR-6 (\$37,106-\$66,665 annual salary range) on the Non-Represented Pay Schedule of Anne Arundel County.

Why the Bill is Important:

HB410 is important because the hours necessary for this position have significantly increased, thus the compensation should increase with it.

Note, the change from NR-15 to NR-6 was made via an amendment that passed out of the Anne Arundel County Delegation Alcohol Sub Committee, and then the full delegation. This increase is also included in the Anne Arundel County Board of License Commissioners budget.

I request a favorable report on HB410.
