The Greater Ocean City Chamber of Commerce, representing more than 700 regional businesses and job creators, respectfully <u>OPPOSES</u> House Bill HB0582 – Labor and Employment -Exemptions from Overtime Pay - Administrative, Executive, or Professional Capacity.
