**HB 1174 - Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class BD-BWL Licenses - Multiple Licenses MC 18-25**

Chairman Wilson, Vice Chairman Crosby, and Members of the Economic Matters Committee,

HB 1174 / MC 18-25 addresses restrictions on the number of alcoholic beverage licenses that one business may hold in Montgomery County, allowing for a second BD-BWL with certain restrictions.

MC 18-25 would allow an individual to hold a second Class BD-BWL license, only to sell on the premises described in the second license for beer, wine, and liquor for on-premises consumption and for only private-label products manufactured exclusively for the holder for off-premises consumption.

This legislation is in response to concerns from businesses in Montgomery County looking to expand their operations and develop . It is important to highlight that not only will this help local businesses in Montgomery County, but the revenues for Montgomery County will increase by \$213,200 in FY26 and by \$187,200 annually thereafter.

**I urge the Committee to give a favorable report on HB 1174 / MC 18-25.**
