Education – Maryland Civic Excellence Program – Established

Whereas 9 states have already effectively integrated a civic seals or engagement program into their school systems; and

Whereas, students who experience high-quality civic education are more likely to: complete college, vote, be confident in speaking publicly and communicating with elected representatives, and volunteer and work on community issues¹; and

Whereas youth civic engagement can lead to increased academic performance and improved social-emotional well-being²; and

Whereas this program encourages student participation in government; and

Whereas students will be encouraged to get involved in their school and community; and

Whereas this bill promotes youth literacy in the legislative process; and

Whereas HCRASC supports "Promoting school-based programs and curriculum that encourage civic engagement and participation" (HCRASC Platform Education)
