# TESTIMONY

February 20, 2025

**Committee:** Senate Education, Energy, and the Environment

**Bill:** SB 555 – Public Information Act - Denials - Pending Litigation

**Position:** Support

**Reason for Position:**

The Maryland Municipal League supports SB 555, which will allow custodians to deny inspection of records pertaining to pending or reasonably anticipated litigation.

According to the Maryland PIA Manual (19<sup>th</sup> Ed.), Maryland courts agreed with the reasoning in *NLRB v. Robbins Tire & Rubber Co.*, 437 U.S. 214 (1978) in a 1984 case, that the Maryland Public Information Act was not intended to function as a private discovery tool. SB 555 seems to extend those protections to documents a custodian believes is likely to end up in court pertaining to the government unit or its officer/employee. This does not impact the discover rights of someone involved in litigation.

For these reasons the League respectfully requests that this committee provide a favorable report on Senate Bill 555.
