EXPLANATION OF DEPARTMENT’S POSITION

The Department supports SB 1028. The locations of the label placement align with these standards and provide additional safety warnings that could prevent injury or death.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Carbon monoxide warning labels have been industry standard since 2007. Stickers are readily available through avenues such as the National Marine Manufacturers Association.

BILL EXPLANATION

The bill requires carbon monoxide warning labels for gasoline-powered vessels.
