

**SB0779 – Favorable**

Honorable Senators

I support

- Specifying that certain requirements under the Climate Solutions Now Act of 2022 are to be carried out **to the extent economically practicable**, including requirements concerning achieving certain direct greenhouse gas emissions reductions from certain buildings, measuring and reporting direct emissions data to the Department of the Environment, achieving certain greenhouse gas emissions reduction goals, and
- achieving zero-emission vehicle goals relating to the State vehicle fleet and local school buses; etc.

I believe that adding “**to the extent economically practicable**” to the existing law, will allow us to bypass some of the more onerous requirements of the Climate Solutions Now Act of 2022 until there is enough electricity generated by Solar and Wind to allow the jettison of power generated by fossil fuels.
